

Steps toward The Blue Helmets of culture

March 2015: Interview of Minister Franceschini The Guardian, urging the interna-

tional community to protect the cultural heritage threatened by Isis.

August 1, 2015: 83 countries signed the Charter of Milan at the summit of Ministers

of Culture at Expo, condemning violence against cultural heritage.

September 29, 2015: Statement of the Prime Minister, Matteo Renzi at the UN General

Assembly.

November 13, 2015: UNESCO adopts a resolution that commits each member country

to set up a national task force, Unite4Heritage, to be used in defense of world cultural heritage, and urges the UN to discuss the oppor-

tunity of a cultural component in peacekeeping missions.

February 16, 2016: Italy is the first national Unite4Heritage task force with an agree-

ment signed at the Baths of Diocletian with UNESCO and by the

then Foreign Minister, Paolo Gentiloni.

March 24, 2017: The UN Security Council approves Resolution 2437/2017 which

provides for the engagement of a cultural component in UN peace-

keeping missions, if requested.
